

Orator

1. The Orator gives opinions concerning the application and interpretation of the laws of the Order and sees that the laws of the Order are observed and properly applied.
2. In matters which relate to the administration of the affairs of the Lodge, the Orator is subordinate to the President.
3. The Orator has the responsibility of calling any infraction of the laws, as listed in the guidebook to the attention of the President.
4. The Orator, either on the Orator's own initiative or upon complaint being made to the Orator, shall have power to prefer written charges against a member who has violated the laws of the Order.
