

Trustees

1. The Trustees examine and audit the books kept by the Financial Secretary and the Treasurer of the Lodge.
2. Trustees examine and audit the quarterly report of the Financial Secretary, certifying as to its correctness by affixing their signatures. Quarterly report must bear the names of three Trustees in addition to the signature of the Financial Secretary.
3. Trustees are provided a “call list” of members from 2nd Vice President. They keep in touch with members on their respective call lists. They receive the names of members whose dues have not been paid from the 2nd Vice President and speak directly with those members.
4. They perform such additional duties in matters pertaining to their office as directed by the President of the Lodge
5. They perform such additional duties in matters pertaining to their office imposed upon them by the laws of the Order or by the deliberations of the assembly of the Local Lodge.
